External Service Providers

Thank you for your patience as we have taken the time to find a model that allows us to work collaboratively with allied health professionals to ensure the best support for the students at Wilson Park School. We currently have an enrolment of 82 students. Every student has a team of therapists, support agencies and medical professionals supporting them. The sharing of information amongst this multidisciplinary team is invaluable to support the learning of all students. Recently requests for therapy sessions and observational visits from therapists has increased substantially. For this reason, to equitably meet the needs of all Wilson Park students and to comply with NSW Department of Education policies we have adjusted our school policy to allow for the ongoing exchange of information between therapists and classroom teachers. An information letter explaining the process will be sent out to all families by the end of the week.
